Now there is a new Jewish settlement in this place where people use the biblical name Gamla as it was used at the bible time. Three thousand years ago, the people of Gamla were fighting against the Romans for several months and the Romans were unable to conquer the village. What they did was just surrounding the village and not letting anybody go out. The people were suffering from hunger.
